From 1st September, 5 new daily buses will travel between Sutton Heath (the bus stop opposite the shop) to Woodbridge (Turban Centre), leaving at 9.20am, 11.20am, 1.20pm, 2.50pm and 4.50pm; with a bus on Saturdays leaving at 3.35pm.

The return journeys leave the Turban Centre at 9.05am, 11.05am, 1.05pm, 2.35pm and 4.35pm; with buses leaving at 3.20pm and 5.35pm on a Saturday.

These buses are in addition to the regular service that runs between Orford and Martlesham Heath (leaving Hollesley Water Tower at 7.20am and leaving the Turban Centre at 5.45pm).

THE WILFORD BENEFICE CHURCHES Wearing of Face Mask in Church Services. The House of Bishops Recover Group of the Church of England issued the following guidelines on 7th August in respect of the wearing of face masks when attending church services:

Face coverings are currently mandatory in places of worship and church halls. Whilst there are exemptions, outlined below, this is a legal requirement:

Exemptions from wearing face covering

- You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to. This includes:
- Those who are leading services or events in a place of worship, and those who assist them (for instance reading, preaching, or leading prayer), do not always need to wear a face covering, although one should be worn especially if physical distancing cannot be maintained (i.e. distributing consumables). This exemption does not apply to worshippers, who should wear face coverings consistent with the requirements for any other public space.
 - These exemptions will also cover the bride and groom at a wedding and those officiating at the wedding.

These exemptions are made to enable communication, particularly with those who rely on lip-reading, facial expressions or clear sound; they do not exempt clergy and other leaders from wearing face coverings in other situations or other activities.
